

Show Day Information for dancers

When: June 22nd

Where: Lyons Township South High School North Campus

- The Showcase will take place at Lyons Township High School North Campus Reber Center
- Dancers should arrive hair & makeup ready for their performance.
- The show will begin promptly at the start time listed.
- Dancers will not be permitted to sit with their parents during the show. (This does not apply to our preschool program dancers)
- Dancers will need to remain in the dressing rooms until the completion of their show. No dancers will be permitted to leave until after their final curtain call (closing number).
- Makeup should be worn for all female dancers. The amount of makeup should be at the discretion of the parent.
- Long hair should be pulled back away from the face in a bun with a left side part. All bangs should be smoothed back and pinned. Short hair should be gelled and styled.
- Princess, Preschool & Mini classes will wear pink tights for both ballet and tap. (tights colors for other classes will be indicated in Handbook)
- The only bags that should be brought with your dancer are the **white garment bag** with all costumes inside and the **Wonderland Tote** that was provided to you. (Competitive dancers may bring their dream duffels & Backpacks)
- All costume pieces should have dancers' names in each piece.
- All shoes should be labeled on the inside of the shoe.
- All dancers must wear tights under their costume. The color has been provided to you. (Hip Hop is the ONLY exception)
- All ballet dancers must wear pink tights, for those with multiple costumes; these can be put on over their nude tights for quick changing.
- It is recommended that all dancers wear a nude leotard under their costume for easy changing.
- All classes must wear tan jazz shoes unless otherwise requested.
- All ballet classes (Petite and below) must wear pink ballet shoes.
- All Hip Hop classes should wear all white tennis shoes. (Depending on the teachers request, this is expressed on your costume sheet inside your production handbook.)
- No drinks are needed. Water will be provided by DPDC. No snacks are needed or allowed. Please plan to feed your dancers before and after.

Opening Number:

All dancers will take part in our opening number! The costume for this number is below:

Wonderland T-shirt over the top of their first costume of the show. The show order will be posted the first week of June.

Closing Number:

All dancers will take part in our closing number! Dancers will wear their costume from the last dance they performed.

Dancers should arrive on show day in their first costume & Opening Number T-shirt on top.
